**GENERAL ORDER**



The automatic stay in the scheduled 362 hearings will remain in full force and effect.


All periods set by statutes of limitations applicable to causes of action, cases and proceedings filed, or to be filed in this court, are hereby extended until Monday, April 13, 2020.

The closing will not affect the court’s electronic filing system.




